

FIVE WOUNDS OF CHRIST DEVOTION

The purpose of the Five Wounds Devotion is to draw closer to Christ and His Passion by reflecting on the wounds He received while on the Cross: the four on each of His hands and feet and the one in His side. It gives glory to these wounds and to the mercy that we are given through Christ's suffering and death. The devotion is similar to the rosary where a wound is stated and then meditated on during the following prayers. A Hail Mary is said at the end of each group of prayers in honor of Our Lady of Sorrows. In recent years, there has been a resurgence of devotion to the Five Wounds, in large part due to Pope Francis who frequently speaks about them in his homilies and public addresses. Many saints have also had a devotion to the Five Wounds, including St. Alphonsus Liguori and St. Francis of Assisi, and it received official papal approval from Pius VII in 1822.
